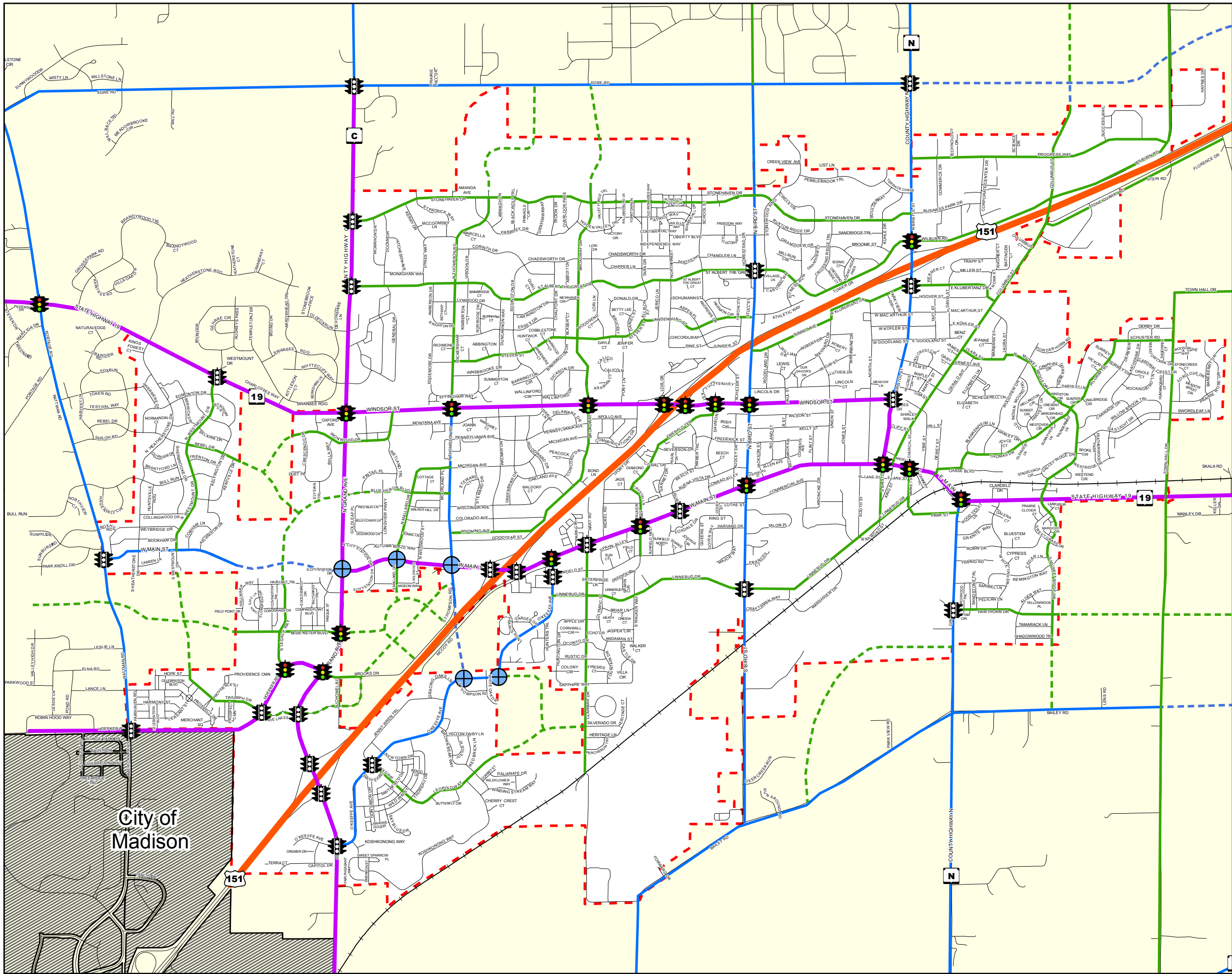
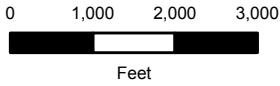
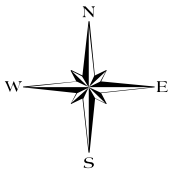




Official Map Street and Roadway Classification City of Sun Prairie

Notes:
1. Street right-of-way widths are established to ensure adequate area for future street improvements. Variations may be granted from this required right-of-way width when deemed appropriate by the City Engineer. Appropriateness shall be determined based on criteria including but not limited to the reduction of environmental impacts due to run-off from impervious cover, the need to calm traffic, and reduced long term costs for street construction, reconstruction, and long-term maintenance.
2. Future local streets are not included on this map, however all new local streets shall form a well-connected network that provides for safe, direct, and convenient access by automobile, bicycle, and pedestrian. Local streets shall provide connections to existing and planned streets and access to local destinations. Streets shall be extended to outer limits of a development to allow for future connections to the street network.
